



ADVANCED RECOVERY COACH PROFESSIONAL ACADEMY

As more entities (hospitals, clinics, providers, courts, prisons, etc...) employ recovery coaches, a Recovery Coach Professional (RCP) embodies a level of competence and expertise. An RCP is proficient in the art and science of recovery coaching through active listening, motivational interviewing, managing biases, and treating people as resources ethically while employing a professional demeanor. RCP's are the 'special forces' of the recovery coach community!

Upon completion of this course, students will be able to:

- Describe the role of the Recovery Coach Professional and its functions
- List the components of and the importance of SMART goals
- Explain accountability in the Recovery Coach Professional role
- Build skills to coach in crisis situations.
- Describe the importance of appearance as a Recovery Coach Professional
- Explain the importance of reliability
- Apply active listening and Motivational Interviewing
- Explore ethics and boundaries
- Discover attitudes about stigma in professional settings
- Explain ethical decision making
- Describe principles, morals, and values
- Increase awareness of the importance of etiquette and demeanor...
- Explore case studies and ethical considerations in different settings.
- Examine ethical guidelines for the delivery of peer-based recovery support services
- Describe accountability and its importance
- Explain the importance of maintaining poise as an RCP
- Describe advocacy and its importance
- Practice newly acquired skills

The prerequisite to taking this class is the completion of Recovery Coach/Life Coach I.
